University Professor Ralph Mösges, M.D. Ph.D. FAAAAI an otorhinolaryngologist and allergologist, was the chairman of the Institute of Medical Statistics, Informatics and Epidemiology (IMSIE, now IMSB) at the University Hospital of the Medical Faculty of the University of Cologne, Germany. His current research fields are allergic and infectious diseases of the upper airways, epidemiology and clinical pharmacology.

Ralph Mösges is the author and editor of ten books and has published more than 400 articles in major journals. He is an editor of the immunology section of The Journal of Clinical Medicine and the associate editor of the allergology section of Heliyon.

He was the chairman of ISCOANA a task force of the European Rhinologic Society (ERS) and serves as a member of the guidelines committee of the German Academy of Otorhinolaryngology for the development of guidelines in rhinosinusitis and in sudden deafness. He chaired the ENT-section of the European Academy of Allergy.

Prof. Mösges is the owner and director of Clinical Research International Ltd. Hamburg, Germany and of ClinCompetence Cologne GmbH, Cologne, Germany, two contract research organizations which focus on methodological and clinical research in the Head and Neck field and in Allergology.
